### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Mutt-Thomason site is one of the few relatively undisturbed Miller II - Miller III village sites [REDACTED] Test excavations in April, 1975, revealed that as much as one-third of the site remains intact. Surface material is scant, but further excavations could reveal house patterns, fire hearths, or storage pits. Few excavations have been carried out on sites of this time period, and future work on the Mutt-Thomason site could provide archaeologists with data on the Woodland Tradition peoples in this area.
