Outbuildings closest to the main house are the kitchen, storehouse and
The kitchen is connected to the original dining room by a covered
way, "the whistle walk," and its doorway has shouldered architrave
The kitchen and storehouse are brick with sand and salt mortar.
pyramidal roof storehouse has two floors and a boxed cornice. The
main barn, to the north of the house, has been reworked.


