

AN ORDINANCE RE-ADOPTING AND AMENDING
THE EXISTING HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Centreville in council convened that an Ordinance related to the establishment of the Centreville Historical District appearing in the Ordinance Book of the Town of Centreville be re-adopted and amended as follows:

1. The ordinance previously adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen establishing the Centreville Historical District is hereby re-adopted to incorporate the powers now permitted to Mississippi Local Historic Preservation Commissions by §39-13-1 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. This chapter is cited as the Mississippi Local Government Historic Preservation Law of 1978.

2. All previously designated local landmarks and historic districts in the Centreville Historical District are hereby expressly redesignated, and these designations shall continue with their previously indentified boundaries as indentified in the National register of Historic Places of October 13, 1992.

3. All current members and officers of the Centreville Historical District shall continue to serve until the conclusion of their previously-stated terms.

The foregoing Ordinance was reduced to writing, introduced, read, considered, and voted upon section by section and as a whole, and the vote on each and all sections upon the Ordinance as a whole was taken by "Yea" and "Nay". Those voting "Yea" being D'Aquilla, Lobrano, Moore, Sanders, West. Those voting "Nay" being none.
