ORDINANCE NO. 2233

HATTIESBURG HISTORIC NEIGHBORHOOD
HATTIESBURG HISTORIC CONSERVATION DISTRICT NUMBER ONE

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE HATTIESBURG HISTORIC
NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT, HATTIESBURG HISTORIC
CONSERVATION DISTRICT NUMBER ONE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HATTIESBURG, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. That the Hattiesburg Historic Neighbor-
hood be adopted as Hattiesburg Historic Conservation
District Number One as per the Hattiesburg Historic Conser-
vation Commission recommendation in connection therewith so
that the land described as:

COMMENCE at a point where the northern margin of
Gordon's Creek intersects with the eastern right of way
of Unetta Street, being in Block 5 of D. H. McInnis
Survey, Hattiesburg, Forrest County, MS, the same being
the Point of Beginning. From said point of beginning,
run southeasterly to a point where the east right of
way of Unetta Street intersects with the northwest
corner of Block 6, D. H. McInnis Survey. Thence run
south along the east right of way of Unetta Street to
the south right of way line of East Hardy Street.
Thence run westerly along said south right of way of
East Hardy Street to the east right of way of Annie
Street. Thence run southerly along said east right of
way of Annie Street to the south right of way line of
East Laurel Avenue. Thence run westerly along said
south right of way of East Laurel Avenue to the east
line of Lot 11, Block 2, W. A. Johnson Subdivision.
Thence run south along the east line of lot 11 and 2 in
said block 2 to the southeast corner of said lot 2;
thence continue south to a point on the south right of
way of Southern Avenue; thence run west along said
south right-of-way of Southern Avenue to the northwest
corner of lot 8, block 1, Maggie E. Ward Subdivision.
Thence run south to the southwest corner of said lot 8.
Thence run west and along the south line of lots 7, 6,
5, and 4 in block 1 to a point being 69.4' east of the
southwest corner of lot 4, block 1; Maggie E. Ward
Subdivision. Thence run south to the north right of
way of Deason Street. Thence west along said north
right of way of Deason Street to a point perpendicular
to the east right of way of an alley located in Block
110 of Deason Subdivision of Kamper & Whinnery 2nd
Survey. Thence run south and along east right of way
of said alley to a point on the south right of way of
Elizabeth Avenue. Thence run east to the northeast
corner of Lot 2, Block 115, Kamper & Whinnery Survey.
Thence run south to a point 150' south of the northeast
corner of said Lot 2; thence run west and perpendicular
to said point to the east right of way of Williams
Street. Thence run south along said east right of way
to a point perpendicular to the northeast corner of Lot
11, Block 116, Kamper & Whinnery Survey. Thence run

west to the east right of way of Illinois Central Gulf Railroad. Thence run southeasterly along said East right of way to a point, if extended, from the south right of way line of James Street. Thence run northwesterly on and along said south right of way line of James Street to the west right of way line of Edwards Street, thence run south along said west right of way line of Edwards Street to the south right of way line of Katie Avenue. Thence run west along said south right of way to the west right of way line of Bonhomie and Hattiesburg Southern Railroad. Thence run northwesterly along said west right of way of the aforesaid railroad to the south right of way of New Orleans and Northeastern Railroad (Southern Railway System). Thence run northeasterly along said south right of way to the northern margin of Gordon's Creek. Thence run northeasterly along said northern margin of Gordon's Creek to the eastern right of way of Unetta Street, being the point of beginning.

and also known as the Hattiesburg Historic Neighborhood be named Hattiesburg Historic Neighborhood District, Hattiesburg Historic Conservation District Number One.

SECTION 2. This Hattiesburg Historic Neighborhood District, Hattiesburg Historic Conservation District Number One will be under the management of the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Commission and will be governed by the regulations of Ordinance Number 2193, the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its passage as provided by law.

The foregoing Ordinance having been reduced to writing, the same was introduced by Councilman Buckley, seconded by Councilman Cummings, and a vote taken thereon, first section by section, then upon the Ordinance as a whole with the following results:






LEGEND
