

ORDINANCE NO. 594

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE KOSCIUSKO HISTORIC DISTRICT, AND TO ESTABLISH THE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY OF SAID DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Kosciusko, Attala County, Mississippi, in recessed meeting on this the 20th day of May, 2004, as follows,

to-wit:

SECTION ONE.

That the Kosciusko Historic Preservation Commission's recommendations for the boundary lines of the Kosciusko Historic District be accepted by this Board, and that the boundary lines of said District be as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of East Jefferson Street and South Huntington Street, run thence South on Huntington Street to the Southern boundary to Bobo Street, run thence Southwest on Bobo Street to Tipton Street, run thence North on Tipton Street to South Natchez Street, then continue South on South Natchez Street to South Street. Return thence North on South Natchez Street, which becomes Wells Street to Galloway Drive, run thence West on Galloway Drive to Woodland Street; thence return easterly to Wells Street; run thence North along Wells Street to the Illinois Central Railroad to the street known as Pilsudsky Street. Then return South on Wells Street to Adams Street, run thence East on Adams Street to Jackson Street; run thence North on Jackson Street to Love Street; run thence East on Love Street to North Natchez Street, run thence North on North Natchez to Knox Road, run thence East on Knox Road to East Street, run thence South on East Street to Lucas Street, run thence West on Lucas Street to Bell Street, run thence South on Bell Street to East Jefferson Street. Run thence East on East Jefferson Street to Veterans Memorial Drive. Return West on East Jefferson Street to Huntington Street at the beginning point of the district.

The district as described above encompasses all property within the above area and all property contiguous to the streets on the outside perimeter of the above area (ie on both sides of said streets.)

SECTION TWO.

That said section of the City of Kosciusko herein above described shall be designated as the Kosciusko Historic District.

SECTION THREE.

That the Kosciusko Historic District shall be under the management of the Kosciusko Historic Preservation Commission and that said district shall be governed under the regulations of the Ordinance Number 590 created by the City of Kosciusko for the establishment of the Kosciusko Historic Preservation Commission, adopted on October 7, 2003 and recorded in Ordinance Book 3 at page 574 thereof.





1. Extends the Southern limits of the Historic District along Huntington Street from Bobo Street Southward to the intersection of Huntington Street and the Kosciusko City Limits.
2. Adds Cherry Street, Oakland Street, Hickory Street, Hines Street, Goodman Street from Wells Street to West Jefferson Street, and West Jefferson Street from its intersection with Goodman Street to its intersection with Wells Street.
3. Adds North Wells Street from the Illinois Central Railroad and Pilsudsky Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 12.
4. Adds Knox Road from East Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 35 Bypass (Veterans Memorial Drive).

SECTION TWO. All other provisions of Ordinance Number 594 not in conflict with this amendment thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE.



AN ORDINANCE TO EXPAND THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE KOSCIUSKO HISTORIC
DISTRICT BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 594

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Kosciusko, Attala County, Mississippi, in recessed meeting on this the 17th day of August, 2004, as follows, to-wit:

SECTION ONE.

Section One of Ordinance No. 594 of the City of Kosciusko, Mississippi, adopted on May 20, 2004, and which establishes the boundary limits of the Kosciusko Historic District, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of East Jefferson Street and South Huntington Street, run thence South on Huntington Street to the intersection of the Kosciusko City Limits and Veterans Memorial Drive; run thence North along Huntington Street to the Southern boundary of Bobo Street; run thence Southwest on Bobo Street to Tipton Street; run thence North on Tipton Street to South Natchez Street; run thence South on South Natchez Street to South Street; return thence North on South Natchez Street, which becomes Wells Street to Galloway Drive; run thence West on Galloway Drive to Woodland Street; run thence North along Woodland Street to Hickory Street; run thence North along Hickory Street to Goodman Street; run thence West along Goodman Street to West Jefferson Street; run thence East along West Jefferson Street to Wells Street; run thence North along Wells Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 12; run thence South along Wells Street to Adams Street; run thence East on Adams Street to Jackson Street; run thence North on Jackson Street to Love Street; run thence East on Love Street to North Natchez Street; run thence North on North Natchez Street to Knox Road; run thence East on Knox Road to Mississippi State Highway Number 35 Bypass (Veterans Memorial Drive); run thence West on Knox Road to East Street; run thence South on East Street to Lucas Street; run thence West on Lucas Street to Bell Street; run thence South on Bell Street to East Jefferson Street; run thence East on East Jefferson Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 35 Bypass (Veterans Memorial Drive); run thence West on East Jefferson Street to Huntington Street at the beginning point of the district.

The district as described above encompasses all property within the above area and all property contiguous to the streets on the outside perimeter of the above area (i.e., on both sides of said streets.)

AN ORDINANCE TO EXPAND THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE KOSCIUSKO HISTORIC
DISTRICT BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 594

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Kosciusko, Attala County, Mississippi, in recessed meeting on this the 21st day of December, 2004, as follows, to-wit:

SECTION ONE.

Section One of Ordinance No. 594 of the City of Kosciusko, Mississippi, adopted on May 20, 2004, and which establishes the boundary limits of the Kosciusko Historic District, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of East Jefferson Street and South Huntington Street, run thence South on Huntington Street to the intersection of the Kosciusko City Limits and Veterans Memorial Drive; run thence North along Huntington Street to the Southern boundary of Bobo Street; run thence Southwest on Bobo Street to Tipton Street; run thence North on Tipton Street to South Natchez Street; run thence South on South Natchez Street to South Street; return thence North on South Natchez Street, which becomes Wells Street to Galloway Drive; run thence West on Galloway Drive to Woodland Street; run thence North along Woodland Street to Hickory Street; run thence North along Hickory Street to Goodman Street; run thence West along Goodman Street to West Jefferson Street; run thence East along West Jefferson Street to Wells Street; run thence North along Wells Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 12; run thence South along Wells Street to Adams Street; run thence East on Adams Street to Jackson Street; run thence North on Jackson Street to Mississippi State Highway No. 12; run thence South on Jackson Street to Love Street; run thence East on Love Street to North Natchez Street; run thence North on North Natchez Street to Mississippi State Highway No. 12; run thence South on North Natchez Street to Knox Road; run thence East on Knox Road to Mississippi State Highway Number 35 Bypass (Veterans Memorial Drive); run thence West on Knox Road to East Street; run thence South on East Street to Crawley Street; run thence East on Crawley Street to end of Street; run thence West on Crawley Street to East Street; run thence South on East Street to Lucas Street; run thence East on Lucas Street to Leonard Street; run thence South on Leonard Street to Fairgrounds Street; run thence East on Fairgrounds Street to East Jefferson Street; run thence East on East Jefferson Street to Mississippi State Highway Number 35 Bypass (Veterans Memorial Drive); run thence West on East Jefferson Street to Huntington Street back to the beginning point of the district.

The district as described above encompasses all property within the above area and all property contiguous to the streets on the outside perimeter of the above area (i.e., on both sides of said streets.)

This amendment to the Kosciusko Historic District includes the following changes to the boundaries of the District adopted by the City of Kosciusko, Mississippi, on May 20, 2004, as amended on August 17, 2004, to-wit:

1. Extends the limits of the Historic District along North Jackson Street from Love Road to Mississippi State Highway No. 12;
2. Extends the limits of the Historic District along North Natchez Street from Knox Road to Mississippi State Highway No. 12;
3. Extends the limits of the Historic District from the intersection of North East Street and Lucas Street along Lucas Street to Leonard Street, thence South along Leonard Street to Fairgrounds Street, and thence East along Fairgrounds Street to East Jefferson Street.

SECTION TWO. All other provisions of Ordinance Number 594 not in conflict with this amendment thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect one month after passage.

This ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, certified by the City Clerk, recorded in the Ordinance Book, and published one time in the *Star Herald*.


