ORDINANCE NO. 2606

THE OAKS HISTORIC DISTRICT

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE OAKS HISTORIC DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HATTIESBURG, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. That The Oaks Historic District be adopted as per the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Commission's recommendation in connection therewith so that the land described as:

**BEGINNING** at the point of intersection of the south margin line of Hardy Street and the west margin line of 1st (First) Avenue to and for the Point of Beginning; thence run southeasterly along the west margin line of 1st (First) Avenue to its intersection with the western right-of-way line of the N.O. & N. E. (Southern) Railroad; thence run southwesterly and along the said western railroad right-of-way line to the centerline of 7th (Seventh) Avenue; thence run northwesterly along the centerline of 7th (Seventh) Avenue to its intersection with the north margin line of West Pine Street; thence run southwesterly along the north margin line of West Pine Street and Broadway Drive to its intersection with the centerline of South 10th (Tenth) Avenue; thence run northwesterly along the centerline of South 10th (Tenth) Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Adeline Street; thence run westerly along the centerline of Adeline Street approximately 185 feet to its intersection with the centerline of a platted north/south alley located between and running parallel with South 10th (Tenth) Avenue and South 11th (Eleventh) Avenue; thence run north along the centerline of the said platted alley to a point of intersection with a platted alley running east and west and parallel with Mamie Street and Adeline Street; thence run westerly along the centerline of said platted alley approximately 185 feet to its intersection with the centerline of South 11th (Eleventh) Avenue; thence run north along the centerline of South 11th (Eleventh) Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of a platted alley located between and running parallel with Mamie Street and Camp Street; thence run east along the centerline of said platted alley 185 feet to the centerline of a platted north/south alley; thence run north along the centerline of said platted north/south alley to a point of intersection with the south line of Lot 4, Block 1, of the Hattiesburg Heights Proper Subdivision ; thence run easterly along the south property line of Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 1, of said subdivision for approximately 170 feet to its intersection with the centerline of South 10th (Tenth) Avenue; thence run south along the centerline of South 10th (Tenth) Avenue for approximately 25 feet to its intersection with the centerline of a platted alley running easterly and parallel with Hardy Street; thence run along the centerline of said platted alley to its intersection with the centerline of Pinehurst Street; thence run north and along the centerline of Pinehurst Street to its intersection with the south margin line of Hardy Street; thence run easterly along the south margin line of Hardy Street to its intersection with the west margin line of 1st (First) Avenue to the Point of Beginning.

and also known as the Oaks District Neighborhood Association be named The Oaks Historic District.

SECTION 2. That The Oaks Historic District will be under the management of the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Commission and will be governed under the regulations of Ordinance Number 2193, the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from after its passage as provided by law.

THE foregoing Ordinance, having been reduced to writing, the same was introduced by Councilman Bailey, seconded by Councilman Rowell, and was adopted by the following vote, to-wit:




