STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Lavelle Site contains approximately ten to twenty centimeters of undisturbed cultural deposits, making it one of the few prehistoric sites [REDACTED] which has not been destroyed by agriculture. Cultural materials collected from the site indicate that it was an Early or Middle Woodland period campsite.
