DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Wisteria Hotel faces west on the corner of Hampton and Central Avenue, across the railroad tracks from the Illinois Central and Gulf Depot in Winona, Mississippi. Constructed in 1910, the three-and-a-half-story frame structure measures seven bays across the facade (west) and eleven bays across the north and south elevations, with a truncated hip roof. An oversized gabled dormer centered on the facade is finished with a Palladian window and heavy boxed cornice with returns. Two smaller gabled dormers flank a central gabled section along the roofline of the south elevation. Dormers and roof peaks were formerly topped with metal crockets. A triple-tiered gallery (no longer extant) supported by Tuscan columns curved around the facade and across the south elevation. The gallery will be reconstructed during the rehabilitation of the building by the present owners. A one-and-a-half-story gable-roof annex extends approximately twenty feet at the southeast end of the east elevation, and is surmounted by a small gabled rectangular tower.

The interior plan consists of a lobby in the southwestern corner of the first floor, with a former dining room and kitchen located east of the lobby now divided into apartments. Corridors leading north and east from the lobby provide access to the rooms, which have been converted into apartments. Decorative features in the lobby are intact, such as the terrazzo floor, brass lighting fixtures, central wooden Corinthian column, and brass cash register. A four-run stair with massive paneled newel posts and spooled bannisters leads from the lobby to an unfinished fourth floor attic. All original millwork is intact, such as the five-paneled doors surmounted by moveable transoms and framed by flat-faced architraves with carved corner blocks. Original furnishings including chairs, bureaus and iron bed frames remain in storage on the third floor.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Wisteria Hotel is a prominent Winoma landmark, associated from its construction date in 1910 with the Illinois Central Railroad and Southern Railroad lines through town. Its architectural significance is derived from the application of classical design elements on the large-scale Neo-Classical structure.

The Wisteria Hotel site was acquired by W. B. and Delia VanKirk in 1910, and the hotel was constructed during the same year (Montgomery Co., Miss., Deed Book 39:310). In its heyday during the 1920s and 1930s, the hotel was a center for the bustling hotel trade in Winona, accounted for by the numerous stopovers of trains of the Illinois Central and Southern railway passenger lines. The Wisteria and the Winona Hotel (situated across the street on the south side of Hampton Avenue) were also favorite stopping places for drummers (traveling salesmen) who peddled wares through the hotels' corridors, and set up showrooms in vacant chambers. When the Winona burned ca. 1935, the wisteria-laden galleries of the Wisteria Hotel caught fire and were destroyed.

As a well-known landmark for both travelers and local residents, the Wisteria Hotel has important contextual and architectural significance for the town of Winona. Its well-proportioned scale and quality of architectural detail will be enhanced following the rehabilitation of the structure by the present owners.
