Upon incorporation of the Y. and M.V. railroad in 1882, the line was rebuilt through Port Gibson and a station was constructed. In 1892 the Y. and M.V. consolidated with the Louisivlle, New Orleans and Texas railroad as a part of the Illinois Central Gulf system.
