


ORDINANCE


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN, MISSISSIPPI, TO ESTABLISH BOUNDARIES OF THE HISTORIC DISTRICT. THE BALDWIN HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION HAS PROPOSED THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT AS NORTH BOUNDARY OF CLAYTON STREET, SOUTH BOUNDARY OF WATER STREET, WEST BOUNDARY OF FOURTH STREET AND EAST BOUNDARY AS FRONT STREET. A PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD ON APRIL 3, 2003. AFTER NO PUBLIC OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED BOUNDARIES, THIS ORDINANCE WAS PASSED.

An ordinance, as styled above was passed unanimously by the Board of Aldermen at the regular Board meeting as conducted on April 1, 2003. Alderman Bruce McElroy made the motion and it was seconded by Alderman Lee Bowdry to approve the boundaries. Motion carried unanimously. A complete copy of the said ordinance is available for review at the office of the City Clerk at the City Hall located at 202 South Second Street, Baldwin, Mississippi.

This ordinance shall become effective one (1) month after its passage.
