PARKHAVEN HISTORIC DISTRICT

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE PARKHAVEN HISTORIC DISTRICT

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF HATTIESBURG, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1. That the Parkhaven Historic District be adopted as per the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Commission's recommendation in connection therewith so that the land described as:

The following herein described is part of the Southwest ¼ and the Southeast ¼ of Section 8, and also part of the Northwest ¼ and the Northeast ¼ of Section 9, Township 4 North and Range 13 West, City of Hattiesburg, Forrest County, Mississippi, more particularly described as follows:
Begin at the intersection of the South Right-of-Way of Hardy Street and the West Right-of-Way of U.S. Highway No. 49, and thence run East along the South Right-of-Way of Hardy Street to the centerline of South 19th Avenue, thence run South along the centerline of South 19th Avenue to the centerline of Camp Street, thence run East along the centerline of Camp Street's Right-of-Way to centerline of Gordon's Creek, thence run Southeasterly along the meanderings of the centerline of Gordon's Creek to the centerline of Eva Street's Right-of-Way, thence run East along said centerline to the centerline of South 18th Avenue's Right-of-Way, thence continue South along the Right-of-Way of South 18th Avenue to the centerline of Adeline Street, thence Continue South along said centerline to a point Due East and adjacent to the Southeast corner of Lot 12, Block 1 of the Forest Park Subdivision, thence run West to the Southeast corner of said Lot 12, thence continue West along the South line of Lots 12 through Lot 3 of said Block 1 to the Southwest corner of said Lot 3, thence run North along the West line of said Lot 3 to the South Right-of-Way of Adeline Street, thence run West along the South Right-of-Way of Adeline Street to the Northwest corner of Lot 12, Block C of the Westwood Subdivision, thence run South along the West line of said Lot 12 to the Southwest corner of said Lot 12, thence run East along the south line of said Lot 12 to the Northeast corner of Lot 14 of said Block C, thence run South along the East line of said Lot 14 for 7 feet, thence run Westerly and parallel to the North line of said Lot 14 to the centerline of Pineview Drive, thence run Northwesterly to the Southeast corner of Lot 6, Block C of the Westwood Subdivision, thence run Westerly and Northwesterly along the South line of Lots 6, Lot 5 and Lot 4 of said Block C to the Southwest corner of said Lot 4, thence run Northwesterly to the Northeast corner of Lot 8, Block A of the Westwood Subdivision, thence run Southwesterly along the West Right-of-Way of Woodhaven Drive to the Southeast corner of said Lot 8, thence run Northwesterly and Westerly along the South line of lot 8 through Lot 1 of said Block A to the centerline of South 21st Avenue, thence run North along the centerline of South 21st Avenue to the Centerline of Adeline Street, thence run West along the centerline of Adeline Street for 40 feet, more or less, to the centerline of an existing drainage ditch, thence run Southwesterly, Westerly, and Northwesterly along the meanderings of the centerline of said existing ditch to the centerline of Adeline street, thence run West along the centerline of Adeline Street's Right-of-Way to the Eastern Right-of-Way of U.S. Highway No. 49, thence run Northerly along said Eastern Right-of-Way back to the Point-of-Beginning. The above herein described contains, more or less, 212.53 acres.

And also known as the Parkhaven Neighborhood, be named the Parkhaven Historic District.

SECTION 2. That the Parkhaven Historic District shall be under the management of the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Commission and will be governed under the regulations of Ordinance No. 2193, as amended by Ordinance No. 2362 and Ordinance No. 2696, the Hattiesburg Historic Conservation Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from after its passage as provided by law.

THE foregoing Ordinance having been reduced to writing, the same was introduced by Councilman Ware, seconded by Councilman Carroll, and was adopted by the following vote to-wit:




