

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE WEST HISTORIC DISTRICT
WEST, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, the Town of West Historic Preservation Commission, created under Ordinance No. 64, is empowered to conduct studies and surveys of architectural, archaeological, cultural and historic resources within the Town of West and to recommend to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of West, the adoption of ordinances designating landmarks, landmark sites and historic districts; and

WHEREAS, the Town of West Preservation Commission did on July 1st, 2008, recommend to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of West the designation of the West Historic District as a locally designated historic district with the finding that the district is historically significant to the Town of West as it includes not only the West National Register of Historic Places district, listed on the National Register on September 14, 1993, but also that area located along the historic view shed along railroad so important to West due to its history as a railroad town;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held September 16, 2008, at West City Hall, West, Mississippi;

WHEREAS, at the regular October 07, 2008, meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen the petition was presented for a vote: and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE TOWN OF WEST:

SECTION 1 DESIGNATION OF A HISTORIC DISTRICT

The following described district shall be designated as a local historic district of the Town of West, Mississippi;

Beginning at the center point of the intersection of Emory Street and Front Street, also known as Highway 51, proceed in a southeasterly direction to the corporate limits of the Town of West; from this point proceed in a northeasterly direction, following the corporate limits of the Town of West, turning northwesterly to follow said corporate limits, to the centerline of Front Street (Highway 51); from this point follow the center line of Front Street in a southwesterly direction to the intersection of Branch Street and Front Street; from this point proceed along the center line of Branch Street to the point where the center line of Branch Street intersects with the rear property lines of all properties facing Main Street; from this point proceed in a northerly direction, following the rear property line of all properties facing Main Street, to the corporate limits of the Town of West; from this point proceed along the corporate limits of the Town of West to the western property line of that property located at the end of Brown Street; from this point, proceed along the western property of said property to a point even with the centerline of Cross Street; from this point proceed in an easterly direction to a point
